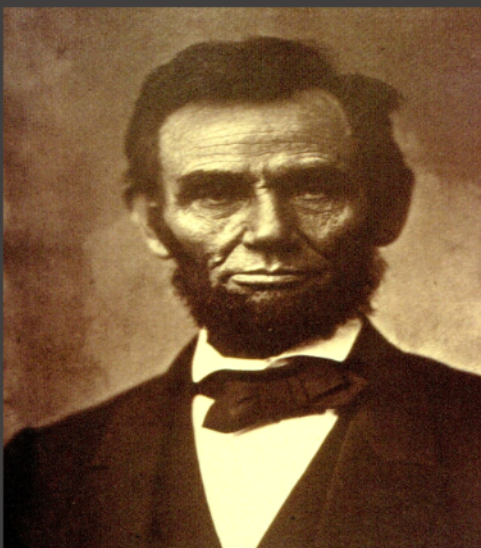


CELEBRATE FLAG DAY

PRESENTED BY THE 77th NEW YORK REGIMENTAL BALLADEERS, THE CONCERT IS A MUSIC AND FILM TRIBUTE TO THE "CITIZEN SOLDIER." EXPERIENCE AMERICA'S WARTIME STORY THROUGH SONG, STILL IMAGES, FILM, VERSE AND SEVERAL SING-A-LONG SEGMENTS.
